## ICE RESCUE SUIT

The FitzWright Ice Rescue suit is based on the well-known FitzWright Model 9700 Immersion suit that carries Certificates of Approval from The Canadian and United States Coast Guard, and SOLAS. The 9700 is the best selling immersion suit of its kind in Canada.

### Materials:

Even though the Ice Rescue Suit is not approved, materials used are the same as the approved Model 9700, including:

### 6.5 mm closed cell foam neoprene

- Resilient and flexible from 60 to -30 degrees C
- Inherently buoyant material provides flotation even if torn or punctured
- Exceeds SOLAS 74/96 Thermal Protection Requirement
- Flame Resistant.

### Gas and Watertight zipper is 100% waterproof

### Features:

- Attached Vulcanized Heavy Duty Rubber boots provide traction on slippery surfaces
- Reinforced elbow pads and Kevlar Kneepads protect user when crawling on ice
- Slim and tapered leg design minimizes trapped air
- Waterproof neoprene wrist seals prevent water entry even when not wearing gloves
- Velcro-closure pocket on left arm for storage of an Ice Pick
- Watertight main entry zipper extends into left cheek for a comfortable water resistant seal around face
- Attached Signal Whistle
- Optional Lifting Harness facilitates rescue by helicopter or deck crane. Design and materials used in harness are identical to the approved version used in the Model 9700.

### Construction:

- All seams are triple glued and blind stitched

### Testing:

Every single FitzWright Ice Rescue Suit is subjected to quality assurance checks at every stage of construction. Each suit undergoes a complete leak test. The suit is guaranteed watertight as it leaves the factory.
